And there are still spots in the Full Day Transitional K class. For our Transitional -K (Blue and Purple Room)classes, please note that you will only dismiss early on the day of your party, but there will be no enrichment either day!

- On Tuesday, February 13, we will celebrate with the Orange Room TTHam3's and our Yellow Room AM class. The party will begin at 9:00 and will conclude at 11:00. Please note this is an early dismissal day for these classes and there will be NO ENRICHMENT offered on these days.
- On Tuesday, February 13 at 12:30, our TTHpm3's and our Yellow Room PM class will celebrate Valentine's Day! The party will conclude at 2:30. Any parent who is not planning to stay for the party should plan to pick up their child at 2:30. There will be NO ENRICHMENT offered prior to the party that day.
- On Wednesday, February 14, we will celebrate Valentine's Day with our Purple Room TK am class, Orange Room MWAM, Green Room AM 4's at 9:00. The party will last 2 hours, and conclude at 11:00. At that time, all children should be picked up from school. There will be NO ENRICHMENT that day.
- At 12:30 on Wednesday, February 14, our Green Room PM class, Purple Room TK pm class, and our Blue Room Full Day Pre-K class will celebrate Valentine's Day. Blue Room parents who are planning to attend the party may arrive at that time. We will dismiss ½ hour early that day, at 2:30.

Hello Orange Room Parents! I can't believe it's almost February. The school year is certainly flying by! January has been so much fun! The children have discovered the writing center!! It is so enjoyable watching what they make from this center! It's stocked with glue sticks, different textures of paper, scissors, foam stickers, letters, words... They learn so much from each area of the room but the writing center is a communication center! Preschoolers can deliver their ideas through their illustrations and printing. Please take some time to ask your child about his/her picture. You never know where their imagination may have taken them that day! We've been practicing our writing skills by copying lines such as /, l, -, +, U, O. And of course, making sure our grip on the marker is correct. Shapes, patterning, and number recognition have also been a focus. We have been learning about the author Jan Brett and one of the books she wrote called "The Mitten". The children took on pretend rolls as they climbed into a huge mitten with their friends and created their own symmetrical mittens using finger paint in the art center! We've been learning what an author and illustrator does for a book and what the parts of a book are called (front cover, back cover, and spine). We are also working on last name recognition. We have been practicing each day going up and down the steps using alternating feet, as opposed to both feet on each step. As we play in the muscle room, this skill will become easier for them as they gain more control over their large muscles. February brings fun and friendship with Valentine's Day and the theme bears/hibernation!
