Our 3 & 4 year old AM classes are all full! We have openings in our MW PM3 or TTh PM3 classes and we have a few openings in our MWFpm and TTHFpm classes for 4's. We filled our Transitional Kindergarten Full Day class, and have two openings left in our Transitional Kindergarten Half Day class, and will look into offering an additional full day or pm option now, depending on needs of future families, as well.

We are looking forward to our Valentine's Day Parties on 2/10 & 2/11. Thank you to all of the parents who have stepped up to help plan the parties! We appreciate all of your help! We look forward to the day when we can have our parents back in the classroom to celebrate with us, as well!!

Conferences will be held upstairs those days to allow parents a little bit of an "open house" since we aren't able to visit classrooms on a daily basis. Please come close to your conference start time, so that there won't be too many extra families waiting in the hallways.
