Thank you to all of our families who took the time to come in for conferences. It is so nice to have the opportunity to sit down with each of you without the rush of drop off and pick up! We are so happy with everyone's progress and growth! We can't wait to see what the rest of the year has in store!

Unfortunately, we have some sad news to share. Miss Carly (Lead Teacher in the Yellow Room and the Orange Room MW pm class teacher) has notified us that she will be accepting a position at a new school, closer to her home in East Canton. Her last day with us will be on Friday, March 8. Parents in her current classes were notified immediately, and coverage for the remainder of the year has been made while we have begun the search for her permanent replacement. Our plan is to have the positions filled by March 13, and be able to invite the new teacher(s) to the Open House for our families to meet. Parents are our biggest resource when searching for reliable candidates (we have never had to run a public ad. We have always found someone related to the program, or a candidate who has been referred by friends of the program), so we hope if you or someone you know may be interested in a teaching position at Loving Hands, that you will send them our way! The positions that we are looking to fill are:

- Monday/Wednesday PM 3's class. The hours would be 11:00-3:00
(Teachers are given 1.5 hours of planning time per day in this position)
- Tuesday, Thursday, Friday AM & PM 4's class. The hours would be 8-3 (teachers are given 1.5 hours of planning time, plus ½ hour for lunch per day in this position)
(the 2 above positions could be combined for one person, like Carly has currently done or separated)
- Enrichment Teacher M-TH 11:00-1:30 (Miss Alicia will have a PM TK class next year, and won't be able to continue teaching it. This position officially starts on October 1. (Teachers are given 1 hour of planning time per day for this position).

The top 2 positions are degreed positions, so we are looking for someone who has a Bachelor or AAS in the Education field, or a related field. For the Enrichment Program, we would also appreciate a degreed teacher, but will base off of Early Childhood experience. Loving Hands is always accepting applications. If you would be interested in being notified anytime a position may be available, send your resume to Miss Shannon. I will keep them on file for future reference.

On Wednesday, March 13 from 5:00-6:30pm, Loving Hands Preschool will hold a Meet the Teacher and Registration Open House. This evening is open to new families who are thinking of registering at Loving Hands Preschool, new families that have already registered for next school year, and our current families who would like to come in to visit their classroom or meet their new teachers for next year. Please pass this info onto all of your friends! You can receive \$20 off your tuition for every referral that you send in!

It is time to start thinking about the Trike a Thon! This year the Trike a Thon will be held on Monday, May 13 and Tuesday, May 14 at 11:30 (between morning and afternoon classes. Classes will be held at their normal time both days, but on Monday, it will be an early dismissal day for the Blue Room. We are looking for volunteers to help with the preparations for the fundraiser. There is a volunteer sign up book at the Information Station outside of the preschool office. Please check it out and see if there is anything that you can help us with! This fundraiser allows us to make updates and improvements to the program! Last year, we raised \$11,233!! Over the years, this money allowed us to make improvements that our budget may not otherwise allow, such as replacing all of the

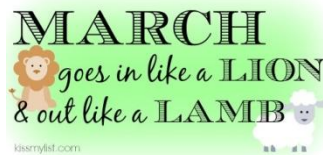
windows in our classrooms (which allow for much better air circulation in the hot months, with no A/C, and much warmer in the winter), replacing the classroom lighting with a more efficient and LED lighting, mats in the muscle room, rubber mulch and a new fence for the playground, new tables and chairs in the classrooms, as well as new furniture pieces and rugs in rooms. Most importantly, we are able to fulfill wishlists for each classroom, for new equipment and supplies for the rooms!!

Scholastic Book Fair will be returning to Loving Hands Preschool from Sunday, March 10- Friday, March 15. It will be open between church services and during preschool hours. It will be closing at 12:30 on Friday to allow for clean up. The spring sale is our thank you to our families for all of the support that you show us throughout the year. Rather than earning books/scholastic dollars for the school, we will be offering our families a BUY ONE, GET ONE FREE sale! This applies to ALL items on sale at the fair! It is a great way to stock up on some new books!! This year, the book fair will also be open from 5:00-6:30 during the Open House! The book fair accepts cash, check (made payable to Loving Hands Preschool) and all major credit cards.

We need your help!! In April, the Easter Egg Hunt will be coming up on April 17 & 18. Soon, you will find empty easter eggs outside of the preschool office. If you would be interested in helping, you can grab a bag of eggs, fill them with a treat/prize, and return them back to school by Tuesday, April 2. We can also use additional eggs, so if anyone wants to buy them at the store and fill them, we will gladly accept!! Miss Brittney, our Administrative Coordinator will be stepping in to help with the organization of the hunt that day, but I would love to give her lots of additional helpers in the AM and in the PM to help with hiding eggs. A BIG thank you to Amy Dvorak and Libby Marks, who were kind enough to step in to take "bunny" duty that day!!! If you can help, please sign up outside the preschool office.
