

We are off to a great start to the school year!! Thank you to everyone for completing your paperwork in a timely manner. We know that the State requires a lot of paperwork from you at the beginning of the school year, but please remember that it is for the safety of all of the children. If we ever had an emergency, we want to have all of the information that we need for every child. It also gives you the opportunity to share information with us, to better know your child. Just a reminder, if you are a new student and haven't turned in your **medical statement**, they will be due NO LATER than October 5. Anyone who has not turned in their form by that date will not be able to attend until it has been turned in. These are ODJFS rules, and exceptions cannot be made. If you need a new form, stop in to the Information Station, outside of the Preschool office and pick up a new one! If you would like to have your physician fax it to us, our fax number is 330-899-9880. There is an updated list at the Information Station to show if we are still in need of your medical statement or a part of it. Please double check to see if you are compliant.

Where do I return things? To help keep things organized and lessen the chance of something getting lost, please be sure to return items to the correct places.

*tuition payments: there is a box inside of the sliding window of the MAIN office. It is labeled Loving Hands Preschool Tuition Payments. If you need a receipt, please make note on the envelope and Miss Brittney will put one in your child's mailbox as soon as payment is registered. Or if you need one sooner, you may ask the office secretary or Miss Shannon and we can provide you with one, as well.

*paperwork, medical statements, fundraiser envelopes (or returned books), etc. There is a basket on the desk (Information Station) outside of the preschool office. It is labeled "paperwork basket." Please return all of these items to my office. It is too hard for teachers to keep track of items left in the classrooms. In order to maintain our teacher to child ratios, teachers are not able to go through backpacks during the school day, so items left in backpacks will remain there.

*field trip money, book orders or items requested by your child's teacher: return to the classroom.

On **Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays**, the church office closes at 1:00pm, so there will be no church office staff available. If you arrive at school to pick up your child, and Miss Shannon is not in the main office yet, please be patient. She may be visiting or helping in a classroom. You are welcome to wait in the area between the two entrance doors. Miss Shannon will be there to open the door before 3:00 dismissal. If you need to pick up your child early, you may press the intercom button in the entrance, and someone will answer the intercom and assist you in entering the building.

As the **weather** begins to cool down, please be sure to send in a jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with your child daily. We will continue to go outside as weather permits. If you would like your child to wear sunscreen, please apply lotion before your child arrives at school. Unfortunately, we are limited on time to apply sunscreen on the children during class time.

The **Kidstuff Coupon Book** sale is coming to an end!! A book was sent home with each child on the first day of school. There are still a few of you who have not returned the book or payment. Please do so by Friday, September 28, so we can begin distributing additional books for those who ordered and close the sale. We can use the funds to purchase supplies throughout the school year! Thanks to all who participated!

For the month of October, we will begin offering our **Enrichment** Program. Enrichment is an optional program for our preschool children. It is offered between 11:30-1:00pm. It is structured like a preschool day, with the addition of mixed age groups (3-5 year old), and lunch time. This is a great opportunity to extend your child's day (9:00-1:00 for AM students, and 11:30-3:00 for PM students) and continue learning progress. On MW, it will be with Miss Alicia in the Yellow Room and on TTH, it will be with Miss Mary Ellen in the Green Room. Miss Stacey will be available for both classes, as needed. There will be a lunch basket located at the Information Station, outside the preschool office. Please place your child's lunch box in the basket BEFORE school (PM students may bring their lunch box to the classroom upon arrival). Not sure if you want to sign your child up for the entire month? You can also use our Stay-n-Play option. As long as space remains, each month we will offer this as a drop in option. Stay-n-Play is the same as Enrichment, but you sign up on a day-to-day basis. The sign up sheet and pricing can be found at the

Information Station, outside of the preschool office. This option will not be available any month where the class is full. There is space available for October.

Fall Picture Day will be on Wednesday, October 10 (Blue Room, Green Room, M/W 3's) & Thursday, October 11 (Purple Room, Yellow Room, TTH3's). Legacy Photo Services of Uniontown will take the portraits. They always do an amazing job! Picture forms will be coming home soon! Payments can be sent in the day of picture day, and <u>given to your child's teacher</u>. We will also have a Spring Picture day in April, but Legacy only takes class pictures in the fall. Even if your child is not participating in individual pictures, they will be included in the class picture (unless otherwise specified) in October.

There will be **no school on Friday,October 12**. We follow Green Schools calendar, and it is a teacher inservice day for the teachers.

The **Purple Room and the Blue Room Transitional Kindergarten** classes will be taking our first **field trip** of the school year to **Maize Valley** on Thursday, October 4. Maize Valley is located at 6193 Edison St. NE; Hartville, OH 44632. Families should arrive at Maize Valley at 9:45. The field trip will start promptly at 10:00. The cost of this trip is \$8 per person. Siblings are welcome, and under 2 years of age are free) Money (<u>cash only</u>)/permission form for the field trip should be returned to <u>your child's teacher</u> no later than Monday, October 1. Field trips replace your child's day, so there will be no PM class that day.

Our **Yellow and Green Room Pre-K** classes will be meeting at <u>Kingsway Farm</u> on Friday, October 5 for their first **field trip**. The first wagon ride will leave promptly at 9:30, so please arrive at 9:15 to give us time to check in. Kingsway Farm is located at 1555 Andrews St. NE, Hartville, OH 44632. The cost of the field trip is \$7 per child (siblings are welcome, ages 2 and under are free) and \$3 per adult (for the wagon ride only). Permission form/money (<u>cash only</u>) should be returned to <u>your child's teacher</u> no later than Friday, September 28. Field trips replace your child's class day, so there will be no PM class that day.

For members of our **Preschool Board**, our next meeting will be on Thursday, October 11 at 9:00am in the Library. Loving Hands Preschool is currently looking to fill 1-2 spots on our preschool board. We typically meet on a Thursday morning each month at 9:00am. If you would be interested in being considered for a seat on our board, please see Miss Shannon.


Scholastic Book Fair is coming to Loving Hands Preschool!! It will be located in the Gathering Area at the main entrance. The

If the time doesn't work for you and you need to come earlier or later than the recommended time, please feel free to come anytime between 5:00-6:30!! We are looking forward to showing you what we have been working on so far!! The Scholastic Book Fair will be open for the evening, as well!



Halloween Parties will be on Tuesday, October 30 for our TTH 3's and Yellow Room and Wednesday, October 31 for our MW3's, Green, Blue and Purple Rooms. Each classroom has volunteer signup sheets if you would like to help for the party. If the sign-up sheet is full, you are still welcome to put your name down too!! Our party chairpersons will contact the volunteers on their list to set up a meeting time to plan the party. This will take place about the first week in October. On each party day: children will

come to school in their costume (BLUE ROOM PARENTS, PLEASE SEE SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR CLASS). Parents will take their children into the classroom, just like a normal day. Parents and other family members are then invited to join us for the Halloween Parade. The parade route will begin downstairs in the Gathering Area, down the halloway and into the Muscle Room. Spectators are welcome to bring a treat/prize to pass out to the children as they pass. Please remember: NO NUTS!! We have several children with allergies this year, so passing out prizes instead of candy is also encouraged. The number of children that we will have at each parade is:

At the conclusion of the parade, classes will meet in the Muscle Room for pictures. Parents are welcome to take a picture of the class in their costumes. At that time, children will proceed to their classrooms to begin the party. Parents who are helping will head up at this time and begin the party. If you are not planning to stay for the party, please plan on picking your child up ½ hour early from school. AM classes will dismiss at 11:00 and PM (and full day) classes will dismiss at 2:30. There is no Enrichment on EITHER of the party days.

BLUE ROOM: The morning will be a typical preschool class for your child. After lunch, they will begin preparing for the party. Please send in your child's costume in a labeled bag. Parents are welcome to come in at 12:15 if they would like to help their child dress in their costume. If you are not planning to attend the party, please note that class will end at 2:30 on Wednesday.

Finally we'll do an art activity and make spooky monsters as we paint with straws.
